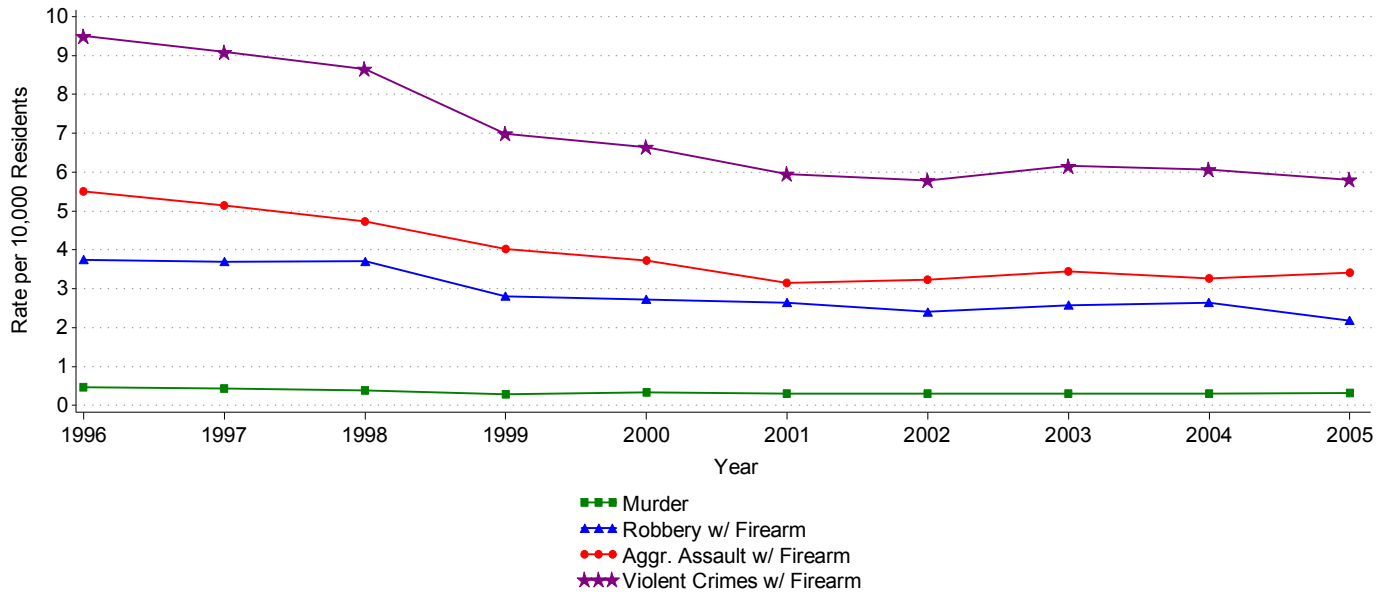


Crime Trends: Washington State, 1996 - 2005
